Job Summary:

Women's Habitat provides shelter and services to women and children who are survivors of violence. Our 25 bed emergency shelter has been providing women and their children a safe place to rebuild their lives since 1978. An Outreach Centre was added in 2006. The Centre features an afterschool program and recreation camps for girls.

Women's Habitat is currently looking to fill two summer student Camp Counsellor positions. We are looking for dynamic students interested in working for nine weeks in the non-profit sector. This is an excellent opportunity for any secondary school student looking to learn and grow with an agency that actively works to end violence against women and children.

With guidance from the Young Women's Counsellor, the Summer Camp Counsellors will plan, organize, and lead a recreation summer camp program for young women between the ages of 10 and 14.
